Offwell C of E Primary School staff will:

- demonstrate and model the school's Core Values;
- place the utmost importance on the safety, emotional wellbeing and learning development of your child. We will bring to your attention any concerns we have and share with you the things we are proud of your child for, we will keep you informed of and engage in discussion with you about your child's progress;
- where appropriate, work with other agencies to ensure the wider needs of your child are met;
- set challenging targets which promote high, personalised standards and good progress academically and socially, and discuss these with both your child and you as we strive to achieve the very best for your child;
- provide a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of your child;
- set and share high expectations of behaviour and attitudes towards learning;
- be open and welcoming, and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- on occasion offer additional homework projects, the scope of which will span a half term. These will be based on the curriculum and topic being taught at the time.

We expect parents/carers to:

- demonstrate and model the school's core values;
- ensure children attend school regularly, punctually and properly equipped;
- inform the school on the first day of any absence, before registration ie 8.50am
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems, including things which may affect my child's emotional wellbeing;
- support the school's policies and guidelines which promote positive behaviour;
- attend parents' meetings and engage in discussion about my/our child's progress with teacher/s.
- support my/our child with the home learning tasks according to school policy.
- read, action and return letters and forms sent home promptly.

We expect the children to:

- show how he/she can live by our school core values;
- attend school regularly and be punctual;
- bring with him/her the things he/she needs;
- wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance;
- try his/her best in all aspects of school life - "first time and every time";
- be polite and show that he/she can be a good friend to others;
- help to keep our school a clean, tidy and happy place to be;
- talk to an adult if something is worrying or upsetting him/her so we can work together to sort it out.
