Do:

- Use both lower and upper case letters.
- Use letters, numbers, and punctuation.
- Position the numbers randomly, not at the end.
- Use special characters, or different languages.
- Use at least 8 characters, but more than the minimum number required!
- Keep it safe, secret, and hidden.
- Choose a password you can remember!

Don't:

- Use personal information, names of girlfriends, boyfriends, family, pets, or places.
- Use your telephone number, date of birth, car number plate, address, post code, or company.
- Use common, easily guessed, passwords (e.g. PASSWORD123).
- Use full words (words in the dictionary).
- Tell anyone your password!
