Staffing

I have received one application for the post of Play Worker at WASP club. Interview currently being arranged.

Pupil numbers

We have 81 children on roll.

Two children who are CiC have joined us, one in Y4 and one in Y5.

Shortly before the half term holiday, we received enquiries from a number of families. We know of 4 more children to join us at a later date.

One child to join Y2 in September, moving into the catchment area.

After Easter / start of Summer Term: 3 children (2 families) joining, one in Y5, one in Y1 and one in YR. This will take us to 84 children.

One further family visited, 2 children, I have yet to hear back.

One child has joined the Nursery.

2 children will join Nursery in the Summer Term. We know some families are intending increasing hours in Summer term. There will need to be a change to how I direct staffing to cover the adult:child ratios. This will be achieved by re-directing staff rather than employing additional hours.

Pupil Attainment and Progress

No update for second half of term, data will be collated at the end of this half term.

Staff are considering and planning for the impact of end of Key Stage testing in both Y2 and Y6 which this year will require use of additional staff to meet access arrangements for children.

Report of the residential to Spain has been shared with Governors.

Governors attended the presentation event where children shared their experiences.

Stakeholder views and correspondence / Parent Council

Significant levels of very positive feedback (all verbal) from parents following Erasmus+ residential to Spain.

At Parents' Evenings, all parents were given a copy of the questions asked by Parent View and requested to complete an online copy. Between 21.2.17 and 3.3.17, twelve responses have been completed online. I have attached a copy of the results. In addition we received 5 paper copies, all responses from these parents were either to agree or strongly agree. One of the 5 is known to have completed online too.

Premises update

Work to the Log Cabin has been completed.

Door hinge covers have been purchased for additional doors and will be fitted.

Data projector has been purchased for Beech, is in use, awaiting fitting of the projector arm.

Staffroom repairs (covered by insurance) following the flood in the summer were found to be more serious than the initial inspection and quote. There has been a temporary repair and the insurers have agreed to cover the larger cost of full repair other than the cost of a new carpet which will not fall within the insurance items covered. This work is to be completed during the Easter holidays.

Structure to cover outside area for Willow class is almost complete, Perspex roof due to be fitted by the Resources meeting date.
