GROWTH Homework Project

Over the Spring Term in Science we will be learning all about plants including how they grow. The homework this term is based on this topic.

In addition to daily reading and spelling practice we would like your child to complete a minimum of two of the tasks below.

- Choose a plant and write 10 interesting facts about it. Present your work in an interesting way.
- Make up a jungle maths game. Think about the rules and write an information sheet explaining your maths game. You can even make a board game to go with it!
- Draw a picture of what you see in the garden, use paint, chalk, felt pens, pencils or crayons.
- Make a garden box out of junk modelling - this should include different plants and trees we could find in the garden.
- **WARNING WARNING** - all plants are dying out. Research what makes plants so important. What would happen if there were no plants? What do we use plants for? Present your work in an interesting way.

The tasks are due in school 19th February when the children will be given the opportunity to share their work if they wish to.
