

1. The kinds of special educational needs for which provision is made at the school.

We work to meet needs within four main areas of Special Needs Provision: Emotional and Social needs; Physical and Sensory needs; Communication and Language needs ; Cognition and Learning needs. We meet these needs at many levels and in different ways, depending on the requirement, for example: emotional support via mentoring; visual support using technology; speech support to make certain sounds correctly; small group support for reading comprehension – these exemplify each area, but are only a snapshot. We have children who require support in each area and some across more than one area.
