#### **Pupils at Offwell Primary School have been supported in their efforts to create an eco garden thanks to a £563 grant.**

The money was donated by the Axe Vale and District Conservation Society (AV&DCS).

The donation came as part of the AV&DCS's initiative to back environmentally friendly projects in local schools.

A spokeswoman for the organisation said they approved the grant because they were impressed by how well the pupils had designed the garden, with special features to attract pollinators.

After seeing the garden, AV&DCS committee member Fran Sinclair said: "They've made an excellent start on their wildlife gardening plans.

"And they have many more ideas to work on, including a 'toad house' and wildflower meadow strips to replace the unused grass at the edge of the school field."
